History & Background

Founded in 2004, this project has the mission statement of “We bring light to the people of Kuyasa.” What started in a 3 bedroom house owned by Linda Klimbashe, The organization started with 20 children and a 3 member staff taking in children between the ages of 3 and 6 years old.

They now have two small buildings that house over 120 children ages between 3 and 6 and house over 80 children ages 0 to 2 1/2. It is amazing to see what they do with such limited space. They are cramped beyond belief. An incredible staff making an incredible difference in the community of Kuyasa. They not only need a ton of ongoing supplies, but they could use a one time gift of \$15,000 which would give them an additional structure to help eliminate some of the space problems. Not only do they take care of all these children (Mostly during the day and holidays), they also run a soup kitchen for the community on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. They would love to run it everyday if at all possible.



This 15' X 15' foot area normally houses between 20—40 children. Space is limited

They could use teams to come and either work as maintenance teams or work with the children. They also need many items like clothes, toys, books, and bibles. One of the interesting things in this area is all the dangerous things in the yards, where some of the children play. Broken glass and sharp rocks are everywhere and the playground really needs to be re-done.

This is the type of project that is saving a community of children. With out this project, over 200 children would be left to mostly defend for themselves and would certainly not have a nutritional meal during the day. It is the type of program that is needed to change the community and the country as a whole.

Current Needs

Many things are needed to get this project into a thriving mode and out of a survival mode. They are:

- One time gift of \$15,000 for container which would be used to help eliminate space problems and allow them to expand the soup kitchen
- Teams to come and do maintenance work as well as provide programs for the children
- Clothes, Toys, diapers, book, and Bibles
- New mattresses for the infants to nap on
- Food on a consistent basis
- Money to pay volunteers a small stipend amount
